

## MONSTER MASK

Do you think it is fair that everyone thinks Frankenstein's creature is a monster because of the way he looks? In this activity, you will make a mask that lets you pretend to be someone or something else!

### MATERIALS

**Collect these materials:**

1. Download the Monster Mask template (or draw your own)
2. Colored markers
3. Scissors
4. One large craft stick, or similar, for handle
5. Tape



### RECIPE



1. Decide what you want your mask to look like. You can add extra parts to the basic shape! Use the markers to color it.



2. Cut out the mask, then make eye holes so you can see.



3. Tape a craft stick to the back of the mask. It will be easiest to hold if you put the stick on the bottom.



4. Now hold the mask up to your face, and look in the mirror! How do you look?
